

## Pastel Drawing Course

In my Pastel Drawing course, recommended for students aged 6 and older, I teach different kinds of techniques, and how to use pastels to draw different kinds of subject matter such as objects, landscapes, and portraits. Drawing and sketching are also taught, combined with the application of pastels. For the first half of this course, oil pastels will be used as sketchy and more detailed effects. For the second half of this course, soft pastels will be used as a more painterly effect.

**Below are the list of art supplies your child will need for this class. If you already have any of these supplies at home, there is no need to buy them new or expensive/high-quality. Recommended places with art supplies include, but not limited to: Blick, Michael's, Hobby Lobby, Office Depot.**

- Pencils
- Erasers
- Toothpicks
- 1 set of oil pastels
- 1 set of soft pastels (*NOT very soft*)
- Pastel paper in various colors (*like white, beige, blue, black, etc.*) (*note: I usually prefer 9 inches x 12 inches but any size paper can be used during Zoom learning*)
- *Q-tips and tissues (for soft pastels only)*
- *Fixative (so that the finished soft pastel artworks do not get smudged or faded)*  
(*note: Recommended use by PARENTS ONLY*)
